NOTES TO STUDENTS

1. We have scheduled at most one exam per day per class group, so ideally there should not be any clash of ordinary exams.
2. As a general rule, where a clash between a Retake/Special and an Ordinary exam has not been resolved, the ordinary exam shall take priority.
3. We have tried as much as possible to space out the units with a day in between to allow for some flexibility. This might not be the case for all students because of the different combination of units being undertaken. In this case, you might have two or more units on consecutive days.
4. Familiarize yourselves with the groups in which you have been registered and taught in (the Group) will also appear on the Exam Card because in most instances the examination venues have been based on such groups.
